Note: There are 16 ounces to a pound (lb), all weights are rounded up to the next pound (lb). For example, with a total weight of less than one pound (lb) the postage would be for one pound. A book that weighs 2 lbs, 11 oz would require postage for three pounds. If you ordered The Town of Esopus Story and Old Esopus Lore the combined weight would be 3 lbs, 4 oz which is rounded up to 4 lbs. These are USPS rules.

## Media Mail

Media Mail is used for books, film, manuscripts, printed music, printed test materials, sound recordings, play scripts, printed educational charts, loose-leaf pages and binders consisting of medical information, videotapes, and computer-recorded media like CDs and diskettes. Media Mail cannot contain advertising.

The maximum size is 108 inches in combined length and distance around the thickest part.

# Page 4 About twice as much as Media Mail but faster

## Priority Mail

Priority Mail® is used for documents, gifts, merchandise, and any mailable item weighing 70 pounds or less. The maximum size is 108 inches or less in combined length and distance around the thickest part. Mark each package "Priority Mail" in the postage area or use a USPS-provided Priority Mail envelope or box.

### Features

Priority Mail service offers two- to three-day service to most domestic destinations. Priority Mail envelopes and boxes are available at many Post Offices and can be ordered online at The Postal Store. You can even print your own Priority Mail labels and postage with Click-N-Ship®.

### Priority Mail "Balloon Rate"

Parcels that are addressed for delivery to zones 1-4 and weigh less than 20 pounds but measure more than 84 inches in combined length and distance around the thickest part must pay the 20-pound Priority Mail zoned rate.

### Priority Mail "Dimensional Weight"

Parcels addressed for delivery to zones 5-8 that exceed 1 cubic foot (1,728 cubic inches) are charged based on the actual weight or the dimensional weight, whichever is greater.
